

Supply List for  
**Comic Book Writing & Illustrating**  
with Ted Bergeron

Each item is about \$2 each and you probably own a pencil and ruler already. I will supply all the paper that we are going to use in this class.

**1 Pencil**

recommendation: mechanical pencil so you don't have to deal with a pencil sharpener.

If you have to buy one, get 0.7mm ... I'll be using a cheap, plastic BIC 0.7mm one. But any lead size will work. And a wooden #2 pencil is fine. There is a pencil sharpener in the classroom.

**1 Eraser**

recommendation: white plastic eraser

Get the STAEDTLER Mars Plastic eraser or Pentel Clic Eraser

A Sanford Design kneaded eraser is fine too if you like them. But the ol' Pink erasers are too abrasive for erasing in this class.

**1 Black Pigment Pen**

recommendation: Pigma MICRON 03 made by Sakura (or Prismacolor 03 fine line marker)

The 05 size is fine too if you can't find the 03 size.

**1 12" T-square or Ruler**

recommendation: C-Thru Junior T-Square 12" (it has a beveled edge for inking) or Helix T-Square (it has a raised edge for inking)

A t-square can help you draw perpendicular lines easier, but you'll be able to do just fine with a plain old 12" ruler. If you have to buy a ruler, look for one with a beveled edge for inking and inches scale. If your ruler doesn't have a raised or beveled edge, don't worry. I'll show you a method to use it for inking.

1 each Mechanical Pencil (fancy STAEDTLER or cheap BIC pencil either one will work fine)



1 each White Plastic Eraser (Mars Plastic or green Pentel Clic. pick one that fits you)



Black Pigment Marker Pen (pick one 03 or 05)



12" T-square or Ruler (you'll be measuring and drawing straight lines in class so either one will work)
