



Call for Work: Teaching Art, Making Art

Friday, November 2-Tuesday, November 27, 2007

Reception: Friday, November 2, 4-7

High school art teachers in the Salem area continue to make their own art even as they instruct hundreds of students each year. This exhibit highlights their personal work and digitally displays the work of their students.

Eligibility

High school art teachers from the Salem/Keizer area are invited to submit one piece of their artwork. All artists teaching art in Salem/Keizer area high schools are eligible. All media will be considered.

Method of Entry

Send a letter (or email) of interest by September 10, 2007. Include your address, phone, email, high school, and which classes you teach there. Bring one of your original artworks and an artist statement to the Chemeketa Community College Art Gallery on Monday, October 29 from 4-6. Attach the entry form to the work. Also, bring up to five examples of your students' work on a PC compatible CD (JPEG format, labeled with the art teacher's last name, the student's full name, title and media). This information should also be included on an accompanying info sheet.

Size Limitations

Flatwork: maximum 72" x 72". Sculpture: not to exceed 75 pounds.

Agreement

Work must have exhibit label (see above) and be ready to display. Wall pieces must be framed and ready to hang. (Wrap-around canvas is fine.) Paper work and any fragile surface must be protected by glass or plexiglass. The gallery has pedestals for freestanding work. Insurance will be provided during the exhibition. For insurance coverage to be effective, a contract must be completed upon delivery of the work. Work does not have to be for sale, but a 30% commission applies to all sales. Work must be picked up by on Tuesday, November 27 from 4-6. Chemeketa Community College will not be responsible for loss or damage to art left on the premises after November 27, 2007. Artists are responsible for transportation of work to and from the gallery.
