## Entering the Program

- Complete a Chemeketa Community College admissions form.
- Meet with Karen Stevens, the Transfer Express Program Counselor.
- Take the placement tests or complete the pre-requisite classes for Writing 121 and Math 111.
- Schedule time for at least 6 hours of homework per week.

**What if you aren't quite ready to take all of the Transfer Express classes?** Karen can help you register for classes that prepare you to enter the program.

**What if you have already taken some of the Transfer Express classes?** Karen may be able to fit you into the group and work around the classes you have already taken.

**What if you want to take more than two Transfer Express classes per term?** Karen may be able to fit you into the program and help you fit additional classes around your Tuesday and Thursday evening commitments.
