CAMP application information

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Either the student or one of his/her parents must have worked as a migrant/seasonal farmworker at least 75 days in the past 24 months. This includes any activity directly related to the production of crops, dairy products, poultry or livestock; the cultivation or harvesting of trees including nursery and forestry work; or fish farm work
or
be eligible to participate or have participated in (a) The Migrant Education Program (MEP)
or
participated in the National Farmworker Jobs Program (NFJP) of Section 167 of the WIA
2. Have a high school diploma or GED certificate
3. Be in the first year of college undergraduate studies (freshman status, minimum WR080, RD080 through the Placement Test or the Alternate WR/RD test)
4. Enroll in at least 12 credits hours per term (full-time status)
5. Must be a U.S Citizen or U.S. Permanent Resident
**DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) do not qualify for Financial Aid; therefore, are not eligible for CAMP.*

CAMP APPLICATION STEPS

1. **Apply for admission to Chemeketa Community College**
 - Submit a free application at **applyonline.chemeketa.edu**
 - You will receive a welcome E-mail or letter that includes your username and Student ID number (K#) for **my.chemeketa.edu**.
2. **Take the placement test (Bldg. 3, Rm 268; 503.399.6556)**
 - Monday, Wednesday, & Thursday 10 am–5 pm (must begin before 3 pm)
 - Tuesday 10 am–8 pm (must begin before 6 pm)
 - Bring your K# and picture ID (no cell phones allowed)
 - Your scores in reading, writing and math will be available immediately after testing. Request a copy for your CAMP application.
3. **Apply for financial aid**
 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available at **www.fafsa.ed.gov**. Chemeketa's school code is **003218**. You will receive an e-mail with a link to access your Student Aid Report (SAR); print a copy for your CAMP application.
4. **Complete the CAMP application packet requirements. Refer to the checklist on the next page**

- Proof of Eligibility
 - Copy of Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from the Migrant Education Program
 - or**
 - Copies of recent check stubs
 - or**
 - Copies of W-2s from last 2 years*Check stubs or W-2s must meet Eligibility Requirements as specified on number #1 on the Eligibility Requirements Section.
- Copy of Student AID Report (SAR) for 2017–2018 from Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Only completed application packets submitted by the deadline will be reviewed.
