How to register for a CLEP Test:

1. Go to: <http://clep.collegeboard.org>
2. Create an account / choose and pay for your CLEP test
3. Print your registration ticket
4. Make an appointment with Testing Services by calling 503.399.6556 option 3 or email testing@chemeketa.edu

You must provide one of the following government-issued picture ID's that includes the candidate's name, signature, and a recognizable photograph:

- Current passport with name, photograph, and signature
- Valid driver's license with name, photograph, and signature
- State or Province ID issued by the motor vehicle agency with name, photograph, and signature
- Military ID
- National ID with name, photograph, and signature
- A tribal Card
- A naturalization card or certificate of citizenship.

To receive a copy of your CLEP transcript submit a request that includes your name, Social Security number, date of the exam and exam test location. You will be charged a \$20.00 fee. Submit your request to:

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS CLEP?

CLEP stands for the College Level Entrance Examination Program. CLEP includes varied Subject exams. Chemeketa reviews and accepts exams based on official scores when you request to have them mailed to Chemeketa by the College Board.

WHO CAN TAKE THE EXAM?

Exams are available to anyone pursuing a college degree. If you have taken a CLEP exam, and did not pass, you cannot retest on that particular exam for 3 months. CLEP exams are timed by the computerized test (timer on screen).

WHERE DOES CHEMEKETA OFFER CLEP EXAMS?

Salem and Yamhill Valley Campuses, offer CLEP tests by appointment. Testing Services in Salem are located in Building 2, Room 101. It is an "open" test site, which means students do not have to be enrolled at Chemeketa to sit for an exam.

CHEMEKETA'S SITE CODE

When registering for CLEP exams or ordering transcripts to be sent to another college, examinees will need Chemeketa's SITE CODE. **Chemeketa's code is 4745.**

WHAT IS THE COST OF CLEP TESTING?

Educational Testing Services fee:	\$85.00
Chemeketa Proctoring fee:	\$35.00

Educational Testing Services fees are subject to change. The fee is payable at the time of your appointment (cash or exact cash only). **The fee for optional essays is \$20.00 in addition to the costs shown above.**

RESTRICTIONS REGARDING GRANTING OF CREDIT

Candidates are not eligible to receive credit for an exam if:

1. The exam duplicates a course for which they have already earned credit.
2. The exam is not one accepted by the college where the student enrolls or has transcripts sent.
