STEP III Personal Statement

Take some time and think about your education and career goals. Please use the Scholarship Essay form to describe those goals and how they relate to your studies at Chemeketa Community College. Be sure to include financial conditions or life experiences in relation to your need for a scholarship. List your community activities, school activities, interests, honors and awards you have received on the second page of this form.

Remember this section is important in determining your scholarship eligibility. It is your opportunity to make a personal statement directly to the selection committee. Give this section some careful thought.

STEP IV Letters of Recommendation

You will need to submit at least two current (written within the last year) Letters of Recommendation. This requirement may vary for some scholarships. Ask either faculty, employers, church leaders or others, not related to the applicant, to complete these forms and make sure the writer signs it. Please attach the writer's business card. These forms will be available in the insert provided with the application. Be sure to check the informational insert carefully. This step is very important to the selection committee. Carefully choose the individuals recommending you.

STEP V Transcripts

Include with your application a current unofficial transcript from the last school you have attended. High school seniors need to submit a current unofficial transcript. Those who have obtained a GED certificate must submit a copy of the certificate along with test scores.

STEP VI Turn in the application

Complete, sign, and return this application and required documentation to the Chemeketa Community College Foundation Office, Building 2, Room 208.
