GED Preparation Program

What does GED mean?

GED means General Educational Development. The GED is equivalent to a high school diploma from the United States and its territories. The GED is for persons 16 years or older who have not completed high school. The five GED tests measure your knowledge and skills in -

writing science social studies reading mathematics

1. Orientation ~ call 503.623.5567 to make an appointment

To begin taking GED classes you must first attend a GED Orientation at Chemeketa Dallas which takes 6 hours over 2 days

Please arrive on time! If you are late and/or do not have the required information, you may be asked to attend the next scheduled Orientation

If you are under 18 years of age you must submit an *Underage Consent Form* signed by you, your parent/guardian, and the school administrator of the high school in the district you live in prior to attending the Orientation

What to bring to Orientation:

- ✓ Chemeketa student ID number. To get your ID number, you must apply for admission. To apply for admission: Submit application at applyonline.chemeketa.edu You will then receive a welcome email that includes your MyChemeketa username, password, and your Chemeketa student ID number (K#)
- ✓ \$15 for a one-time testing and application fee
- ✓ Voucher or purchase order if you are sponsored by an agency

During Orientation you will:

- Receive information about the GED program
- Take assessment tests and learn about your assessment scores
- Complete registration and student forms for class
- Learn techniques to help you become a successful student

2. Attend Classes ~ day or evening

Classes are offered in an individualized study format with small-group workshops

Winter 2012:

Cost is \$70 for daytime: 9am-11:50am Monday-Friday

Cost is \$40 for evening: Monday & Wednesday 6:00pm-8:00pm

3. GED Test Registration ~ stop by to sign up

Make an appointment for the GED Test Registration ~ Come see Beth at Dallas Chemeketa Mondays-Thursdays 9am-2pm

- **Cost is \$125 for the non-refundable GED Testing fee.** You will pay at the time you make the appointment
- Appointment and payment must be made at least one day prior to the GED Test Registration
- Cost to retest is \$15 for each test

Attend GED Test Registration ~ Please arrive on time!

- If you are late and/or do not have the required information, you may be asked to reschedule

What to bring to GED Test Registration:

- ✓ Current government-issued photo ID (DMV License/ID card, military ID, or passport)
- ✓ Receipt of payment for GED Testing
- ✓ Underage Consent Form if you are under 18 years of age
- ✓ Purple bubble sheet & letter of release for testing if you are a GED Options student sponsored

4. GED Test (s) ~ call or stop by to sign up

Make an appointment for the GED Test(s) you want to take ~ Contact Beth at 503.316.3249 or stop by Dallas Chemeketa Mondays-Thursdays 9am-2pm

- You must complete the GED Test Registration (Step 3 above) prior to making appointment for GED Testing
- You must make an appointment for *each* of the five tests
- Make testing appointments as soon as possible because space is limited
- Appointments must be made at least one day prior to the testing date

Please arrive on time! Only students who check in on time will be allowed to take the test
