## **Plumber Apprenticeship**

This is a 4-year program that combines 7,700 hours of on-the-job training with concurrent related-training credit courses.

The first step is to apply during an opening with the Plumber JATC. Successful applicants are hired by plumbing contractors and registered with the Committee. They then sign-up for classes.

Apprentices earn 13 academic credits a year and attend classes in the fall, winter and spring.

### **Additional Training and Degrees**

Credits can be applied to a Certificate or AAS degree and can transfer to OIT for a BS degree.

### **Qualifications**

1. Proof of age—18 years or older
2. High school diploma or GED Certificate
3. High School transcript with 1 year Algebra or equivalent with grade “C” or higher **OR** one post high school algebra course with a grade “C” or higher **OR** place into Math 060 or higher on the Chemeketa Math Placement Test.
