Sheet Metal Apprenticeship

This is a 4-year program that combines 7,200 hours of on-the-job training with concurrent related-training credit courses.

The first step is to apply during an opening with the Mid-Valley Sheet Metal JATC. Successful applicants are hired by Sheet Metal contractors and registered with the Committee. They then sign-up for classes.

Apprentices earn 15 academic credits a year and attend classes in the fall, winter and spring. First year classes are open to the public.

Additional Training and Degrees

Credits can be applied to a Certificate or AAS degree and can transfer to OIT for a BS degree.

Qualifications

1. Proof of age—17 years or older
2. High school diploma or GED Certificate
3. High School transcript with 1 year of algebra or equivalent with grade "C" or higher, OR one post high school algebra course with a grade "C" or higher OR place into Math 060 or higher on the Chemeketa Math Placement Test.
