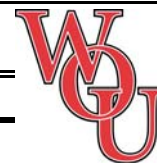

**NOTE:** Two terms of the same college-level foreign language, with a grade of C or higher, is required for admission to universities in the Oregon University System. This applies only to students graduating from high school beginning 1997 or later. This is not a requirement to earn the AS. This requirement may also be met by completing two years of the same foreign language at the high school level. GPA admission requirements for the four year OUS colleges are not necessarily satisfied with an AS degree. The AS degree does not automatically meet the general education requirements at most OUS universities, but the AS will meet the LACC's at WOU if you are transferring into one of the majors listed below:

Anthropology, Art, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Criminology, Economics, English, Geography, Health Promotion, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Speech, or Theater Arts.

Please contact your school of choice for their specific requirements if you plan to transfer to a university besides WOU or into a major that is not listed above. An academic minor is required to earn a bachelor's degree at WOU. Minors are selected to compliment your major. A minor should be selected with the help of your WOU advisor.

\* A maximum of 16 P/NP credits will be allowed on AS degree. "Pass" grade will NOT be changed to a letter grade.

\* A maximum of 3 credits of PE185 may be applied toward an AS degree.

\* Career & Technical Courses cannot be used to satisfy any of the degree requirements for the AS degree.
