



TRiO Talent Search and Mentor Program
Criminal Check Authorization

Oregon Revised Statute 181.555 and Oregon State Police Administrative Rule #257-10-025 allow a Criminal Justice Agency to access Oregon State Police criminal offender records to determine if an individual has a criminal record, if that information is to be used for specific purposes, including “legitimate needs.”

The college believes a legitimate need exists for Chemeketa Community College students involved in the TRiO Talent Search and Mentor Program to undergo a computerized criminal history search to determine if participating students have a criminal history that may preclude the student from participating in this program.

As a requirement of the application process for participation in the TRiO Talent Search and Mentor Program, my signature authorizes the Chemeketa Community College Department of Public Safety to conduct a criminal records check. Refusal to allow a criminal check will forfeit my ability to participate in this program.

Information obtained by the Department of Public Safety is not public and will not be available to unauthorized personnel. TRiO Talent Search Mentor Program staff will only be notified if there is no criminal record or if a criminal record exists which would preclude participation in the program.
