Chemeketa Art Student Show

Call for Entries



Eligibility

All levels of Chemeketa students who are currently enrolled in or who have completed a credit art class in the last two years are invited to submit up to two of their artworks to be considered for possible inclusion in this exhibit. The following media are eligible: Painting, Drawing, Design, Printmaking, Ceramics, Digital Art, Photography, Mixed Media, Glass, Sculpture, Interactive and Time-based Media, Graphic Design.

Prizes

Over \$250 in prize money and purchase awards. No entry fee necessary.

Presentation

All artwork must be ready to hang. Two-dimensional work on paper must be properly matted and preferably covered with clear acetate or framed under glass or plexiglass. Students should note that jurors play close attention to presentation and may exclude work improperly presented. Questions regarding presentation and framing should be directed to the Chemeketa Art Gallery in advance of delivery deadlines. Students needing assistance matting their work should contact Kay Bunnenberg in the Art Gallery. Entry forms are available in the Art Gallery, Building 3, Room 122 or on the art gallery website.

Notification of Jurying

Students should come to or call the Chemeketa Art Gallery on Friday, May 22, from 12 to 2 PM to find out if their work has been selected for the exhibition. Works not accepted for the exhibit must be picked up at this time. Since gallery space is limited, only some of the submitted entries can be accepted for exhibition. Jurors often select work which reflects strong design, originality, and superior craftsmanship.

Reception

Opening Reception is Wednesday, May 27, 12:00 to 2 PM in the Art Gallery. Awards will be presented at 12:15.

Delivery Dates

All artwork is to be delivered to the Chemeketa Art Gallery on Wednesday, May 20, 10-6.

Pick-Up

Work not juried in can be picked up Friday, May 22 from 2-4 or Tuesday, May 26 10:30-12:30. Artwork chosen for exhibition is to be picked up on Monday, June 8, 12-2 PM, or Tuesday, June 9, 10-12.
