Wednesday, Dec. 9, 2-5 Pick up artwork

### Eligibility

Students, faculty and staff from all Chemeketa Campuses are invited to submit work. For 2-D artists, the limit is 2 wall pieces and 6 small or shrinkwrapped pieces. For 3-D artists, the limit is two pedestal pieces and 6 smaller works such as glass pendants or pottery cups. All media will be considered.

### Method of Entry

Bring your original artworks and the completed entry form to the Art Gallery on Wednesday, December 2, from 2-5. Forms will also be available at the drop off.

### Size Limitations

Wall pieces maximum 72" x 72". No work to exceed 75 pounds. Shrinkwrapped items not to exceed 30 X 40.

### Agreement

All work must have exhibit label attached and be for sale. Wall pieces must be ready to display and framed with hanging mechanisms attached. Special hanging instructions must be provided for unique work. Loose drawings and prints are acceptable only if shrinkwrapped or otherwise protected. and will be displayed in print racks. Pedestals are available for freestanding work. Insurance will be provided during the exhibition. For insurance coverage to be effective, a contract must be completed upon delivery. The Chemeketa Foundation will retain 30% of all proceeds and entrants can choose to donate all proceeds to student art scholarships. Due to space limitations, not all work will be displayed at all times. Work must be picked up on Wednesday, December 9 from 2-5. Chemeketa Community College Art Gallery or its employees will not be responsible for loss or damage to art left on the premises after this date. Artists are responsible for transportation of work to and from the gallery.
