NOTES:

1. Admissions Procedure for Transfer Students:

A) Deadlines: Fall semester enrollment = April 15

Spring semester enrollment = December 1

B) The following are required:

a) Completed Common Application.

b) \$40 non-refundable application fee.

c) Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.

d) One recommendation from a college professor or a former high school teacher. Work recommendation accepted via approval of transfer coordinator.

e) Official final high school transcript if fewer than two years of full time college coursework has been completed.

f) Official SAT (Scholastic Achievement Test) ACT (American College Test) scores if fewer than two full years of full time college coursework has been completed.

C) International and Non-Degree students may have different admission procedures/requirements.

2. One quarter credit equals 0.67 (two thirds) semester credit.

3. A maximum of 8 semester hours (15 quarter hours) of paracurricular courses can be taken to apply toward graduation.

4. Courses in which a "C-" or lower grade has been earned will not transfer to Linfield.

5. A maximum of 72 semester hours (108 quarter hours) will be accepted from two-year colleges. A total of 125 semester hours (187 quarter hours) are required to graduate from Linfield with a Bachelor of Science or a Bachelor of Arts degree. To graduate, a candidate must achieve a 2.00 cumulative G.P.A. (Minimum).

6. No fewer than 30 semester credits must be earned from Linfield College, including 20 of the last 30 and 15 credits in the major.

7. The foreign language requirement for the BA degree may be satisfied by earning 8 semester credits (12 quarter credits) of language study at the first-year level or by one, five-credit, course beyond the elementary level (available at Linfield).

8. In most cases, transfer students will not fulfill all of the Linfield Curriculum (general education) credits before entering.

Linfield College does not recognize the Oregon Transfer Associate of Arts degree as one unit; each course is evaluated for individual credit.
