### **Chemeketa Description/History**

The Chemeketa Community College District was formed in 1969 encompassing 2600 square miles and four counties. Chemeketa is a comprehensive public community college with seven campuses and with additional class sites in thirty other communities. Chemeketa enrolls over 64,000 students per year (10,321 FTE), or nearly one out of every five district residents. Chemeketa's strategic intent as a college is to fulfill three promises to our community:

- *We promise to actively encourage and support the achievement of literacy and college readiness;*
- *We promise to open the door to all levels of college for the members of our community, including those who traditionally have not been able to access a college education;*
- *We promise to create and sustain centers of excellence in technical training, workforce development, and business support.*
