BP 3500 -- Campus Safety/College Safety & Security

The safety of students, employees, and visitors, as well as the security of facilities, is a major consideration in the operations of Chemeketa Community College. Every reasonable effort will be made to eliminate or mitigate causes of accidents, fire exposures, occupational hazards, and civil unrest associated with college activities.

To accomplish this, the college will follow reasonable safety practices such as providing necessary safeguards, fostering a safe educational and working environment, providing emergency preparedness and response, and developing safety plans for college events. Students, employees, and visitors are encouraged to report safety and security matters to Public Safety, Facilities and Operations, Safety Committee, or other administrative offices as deemed appropriate.
