

BP 5010 -- Admissions & Concurrent Enrollment

Chemeketa Community College has an open door policy. Persons who can profit from the instruction offered, may enroll in classes if they are 18 years of age or older.¹ Persons wishing to enroll at the college must follow admissions procedures.

Persons wanting to enroll in credit or non-credit classes shall follow admissions procedure #5110.

Persons under 18 years of age who do not have a high school diploma or GED shall follow special admissions procedure #5111.

Persons not meeting minimum assessment scores to be placed in college courses shall follow special admissions procedure #5112.

Enrollment is limited in some academic programs; persons seeking admittance to such programs shall follow special admission procedure #5113.

Persons holding non-immigrant Visas wishing to enroll at the college shall follow special admissions procedure #5114.

Persons who do not enroll in the term for which they have applied for admission or students who have a break in enrollment shall follow the readmission procedure #5115.

Chemeketa identifies a person as a student upon initial enrollment in a course. Enrollment may be refused to persons who have delinquent financial obligations to the college.
