

BP 7210 -- Academic Employees / Faculty: Definition

Faculty are those persons hired by the college to perform teaching, student counseling, and/or other duties (e.g., program chair, reference librarian responsibilities, cooperative work experience instructors, instructors in credit classes, and instructors in noncredit programs of Adult Basic Education, English for Speakers of Other Languages, High School Partnerships, General Educational Development, Online, and Chemeketa Press) as directed by their immediate administrator, director, and/or dean.

Definitions:

- **Full-Time Faculty** are those faculty members hired into positions designated by the college as full-time.
- **Part-Time Faculty** are those faculty members hired into positions designated by the college as part-time and who meet the definition set forth in the faculty contract.¹
- **Adjunct Faculty** are those part-time faculty members hired into positions designated by the college as part-time and who meet the definition set forth in the faculty contract.²
