I take great pleasure in presenting our 2015 Chemeketa Foundation Annual Report. It affirms how, together, we are helping deserving students make their educational dreams and personal aspirations a reality. When you give to scholarship funds, you aren't just supporting individuals, you are investing in all the ways our students will make a positive difference in their families, communities and careers.

In 2015, **2,002** students applied for Chemeketa Foundation scholarships. **507** scholarships were awarded. **\$4,227** was the estimated cost of attending Chemeketa for one term (tuition, fees, books, rent, transportation, personal expenses, etc.). **\$1,200** was our average scholarship award.

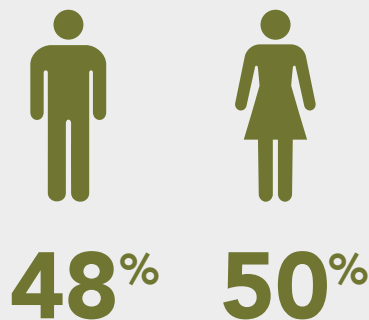

*I want to show my mom that dreams do come true with determination and hard work."*



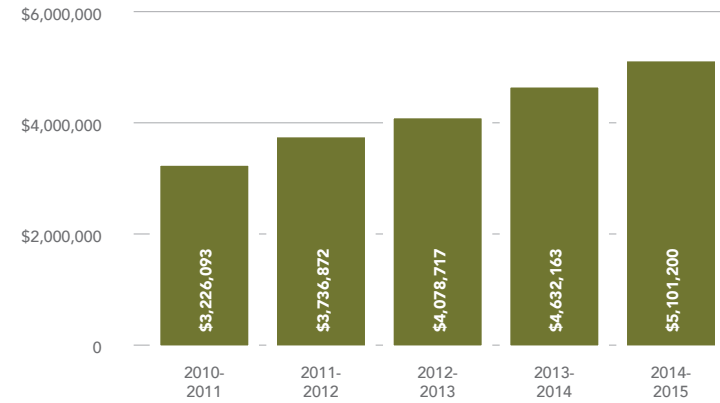

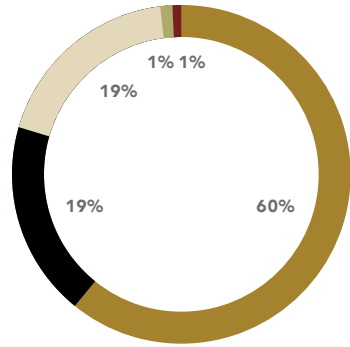
# dollars & cents
