

# Smarter Balanced Placement at Chemeketa Community College

## What is Smarter Balanced (SBAC) placement?

Public high schools in Oregon give the SBAC standardized test in 11<sup>th</sup> grade. If your scores were high enough you may be able to use them for placement at Chemeketa instead of taking a placement test. If you already took the Accuplacer placement test at Chemeketa you can still bring in a copy of your SBAC scores if it gets you a higher placement.

English Language Arts <b>OVERALL</b>	4 plus Senior English	WR 121 and RD 120
	3 plus Senior English	WR 121 and RD 120
	2, 3 or 4	WR 115 and RD 115 (or take Accuplacer)
	1 or no SBAC score	Take Accuplacer
Math	4	MTH 112 or MTH 241
	3	MTH 105 or MTH 111 (or take Accuplacer)
	1, 2 or no SB score	Take Accuplacer

## Will Chemeketa Scholars accept SBAC placement?

Yes, get a copy of your SBAC scores, submit them to Chemeketa and log in to My Chemeketa to see the placement results. You'll need to print a copy of the placement from My Chemeketa to submit with your Chemeketa Scholars application.

## How do I get a copy of SBAC scores?

We suggest you call the high school and ask for a copy of your SBAC scores. Make sure it shows the name of the high school, your name and the dates the tests were taken. The scores should show your scores and achievement levels in Mathematics and overall English Language Arts.

## How do I submit the scores to Chemeketa?

Write your Chemeketa ID number (It begins with a K) on the SBAC scores. You can submit them in person at any Chemeketa testing location. We also accept them as email attachments or as a fax as long as your Chemeketa K# is included.

## How long does it take for Chemeketa to process my SBAC scores?

Scores are reviewed and placements are entered into your student record in 1-2 business days.

## How long are SBAC scores and placements useful?

You can use your SBAC scores for placement as long as you register within one year of high school graduation.

## What if I want to try for a higher placement than my SBAC placement allows?

Come in to take Accuplacer, which gives you the option to try for a higher placement. There's no risk.
