Students must have a minimum of at least 90 acceptable credit hours with a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all college-level work to be admitted to the School of Business. In addition, a 3.0 GPA is required in BA101, EC201, 202 and BA211, 212, 213 for automatic admission. Core courses must be taken for a letter grade. If a graded course is repeated, both course grades are counted in computing the cumulative GPA, but only the second grade is used in calculating the core GPA. Students may only retake pre-business core courses one time. All courses required for admission to the major must be taken graded if taken Fall 2010 or later. This includes math, writing, and BA240 as well as pre-business core courses. **Students are encouraged to complete the ASOT/Business degree prior to transfer to UO. Note: Students who do not meet the minimum GPA for automatic admission may be considered in a more competitive, holistic review process. STUDENTS WHO HAVE EARNED AN OREGON ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (ASOT) TRANSFER DEGREE FROM CHEMEKETA WILL HAVE SATISFIED THE UNIVERSITY'S WRITING, & GROUP REQUIREMENTS. THE MULTICULTURAL REQUIREMENT IS NOT SATISFIED BY COMPLETION OF THE ASOT DEGREE UNLESS ACCEPTABLE COURSES ARE TAKEN AS PART OF THE DEGREE.
Students graduating from high school in 1997 or after must have completed two years of high school-level second language or two terms of a college-level second language or demonstrated proficiency to be admitted to U of O.

Requirements for Graduation
(Not required for admission to College of Business)

Non-Business Breadth Requirement-

24 credits from an interrelated set of courses, outside of business, that relate to your career interests. Completion of a minor will automatically fulfill this requirement, as will two years of foreign language.

Global Context for Business Decisions - three courses that focus on the culture (social, historical, or political aspects) of a country other than your native country. All three courses should focus on the same country or region. Language courses beyond the first year are eligible.

** U of O Lundquist College of Business recommends two years of foreign language. The foreign language requirement for the BA will also meet the non-business breadth requirement and the Global Context for Business Decisions requirements.

NOTE:

1. Students seeking a B.S. degree will have completed the BS Mathematic degree requirement with the math sequence required for business major with a grade of C- or higher. Students seeking a B.A. degree must complete 36 credit hours of Language and Literature and proficiency in a foreign language equivalent to completion of a second-year, college-level, foreign language course. Courses should be selected from the lists on other side of this sheet or courses offered at U of O.

NOTE: For students who have not earned an Oregon Block Transfer degree (AAOT/ASOT) prior to matriculating at the UO, courses used to fulfill the foreign language requirement for the Bachelor of Arts degree may not also be used to fulfill the Arts & Letters groups requirement. Courses used to demonstrate proficiency in Mathematics or Computer and information science (or a combination of the two) for the Bachelor of Science degree may not also be used to fulfill the science group requirement.

2. A maximum of 124 credit hours taken at a community college may be transferred to U of O. A maximum of 12 credit hours of vocational/technical courses are accepted. Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 are accepted at U of O (see exception below).
3. The following courses will not be granted credit at U of O: RD115.
4. Courses in which "D" grades have been earned will transfer to U of O, but will not satisfy degree requirements in writing, mathematics, or foreign language and may not be acceptable for major requirements.
5. Students majoring in Business or Accounting must complete WR121 and 122 and MTH111 before transferring to U of O.
6. This guide is subject to change without notice and should not be regarded as a contract between U of O and students attending Chemeketa Community College.

ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

Transfer students who plan to major in Business Administration or Accounting must first apply for admission to the University of Oregon through the University's Office of Admission. Transfer students are admitted as Pre-Business Administration (PBA) majors. Transfer students with a GPA below 3.0 will be admitted as an undeclared major, and must meet with an advisor prior to declaring PBA as a major. Students are advised to contact the Lundquist College of Business one term prior to transferring. Once pre-business requirements are fulfilled or the last pre-business course is in progress, students may apply for major status. Major status is required in order to register for junior and senior level business courses. Applications are processed each term and are due on the first Friday of the term previous to the term you are seeking admission (with the exception of summer term). Copies of transcripts should accompany the application to the College of Business as well as the application for admission into the UO.

Application for financial aid should be mailed between January 1 and February 1 for fall term to receive priority consideration. Applications will be available December online. Students applying for Financial Aid/Scholarships should make application for admission in February. FA applications are not processed at the U of O unless an application for admission is on file.
Admission applications for U of O are available in the Chemeketa Counseling office. Fall term application deadline for transfer students is May 15.
