QUALIFICATIONS & RESTRICTIONS

Admission to Chemeketa

Age Restriction

Exchange students must be 18 years of age and have completed high school or equivalent prior to departure. If you are between 16 and 18 years old you are allowed to take classes at Chemeketa. You must complete the Underage Admissions Application process before registering for classes that are offered &/or are required to be taken prior to applying. • GPA & Other Academic Restrictions
